

## **EDM Project 7 ACCESS Assignment**

This fall all Mobile and Baldwin County High Schools will have ACCESS. A copy of the news release is available at

ACCESS was available last year in 4 Mobile (Bryant, Citronelle, Montgomery and Satsuma) and 2 Baldwin County (Daphne and Robertsdale) high schools. Partial labs are now available in the remaining 9 Mobile high schools and will be completed this fall (2008). If you are interested in visiting another high school, call and see whether the ACCESS lab is now operational or when it will be. The 5 Baldwin County high schools currently without ACCESS labs are scheduled to open full ACCESS labs in the fall of 2009.

You have a blog assignment to do with regard to ACCESS (also one on ALEX). Do that assignment.

Then

1. Call one of the Mobile or Baldwin County High Schools that has a full ACCESS lab. Make an appointment to visit the lab.
2. Arrange for a demonstration (individual or group). Try to use the equipment yourself if at all possible.
3. Take a digital camera with you and have your picture taken at the lab. If you need to borrow a camera, that can be arranged through your instructor.
4. Discuss with the ACCESS director and any other people who are in the lab at the same time that you are what uses are being made of ACCESS and what possibilities exist for future us. Think about how YOU could use ACCESS also.
5. Write up your report. Post it to your blog. Include your picture in your post.

You can go with other members of EDM 310 classes if you so desire.

### **Will I be graded on this project?**

Absolutely! The more imaginative, thoughtful, and successful that your contact, conversation and report is, the better your grade. This is one of eight projects and two exams. This project, therefore, constitutes 10% of the course work for which you are responsible in this class.
