1. Check your assignments weekly. Depending on the number of requests we get, some weeks may not have assignments.
2. Include in every post:
  - a. Your Name
  - b. The fact that you are in Dr. Strange's class at the University of South Alabama
  - c. Your class blog URL
3. Your comment should be a cogent, related and supportive comment and/or question. Be helpful and positive. The comment does not have to be long. But it must be clear that you have read the student's blog and must include your reaction to what was written. Tell a bit about yourself if you like.
4. In some cases your comment may be moderated (have to be approved by the teacher first). Don't be surprised about this. You can return later to see the comment.
5. Do your Comments on THURSDAY if at all possible. Students look for them on Fridays.
6. After you have done your comments, write a brief post to your blog describing the posts made by the kids.
7. Try to find out as much as possible about the teacher and the class. Get a sense of how the teacher is using blogs and other technologies in his/her classroom.
8. Include your thoughts about the class in your post.
